

## Modular combinations for the designated certificate in General Small Animal Surgery (GSAS)

The following small animal modules are available, either as free-standing modules or as part of the Certificate in Advanced Veterinary Practice and the designated certificates in General Small Animal Surgery. The designated certificate available within this group is CertAVP (General Small Animal Surgery)

Candidates who have achieved 20 credits from a combination of the A-Professional Key Skills module.1 (A-PKS.1) **AND** the B-Clinical Key Skills.0 (B-CKS.0) module may use these towards their designated certificate in place of the A-Foundations of Advanced Veterinary Practice (A-FAVP.1) module **AND** the “Free Choice” module.
